

FISHING RULES

Ljungdalen Fisheries Conservation Area Fishing rules All fishing within Ljungdalen's fisheries conservation area must be sustainable in the long term, for that reason there are general fishing rules and locally adapted fishing regulations.

GENERALLY:

- 1) Sport fishing is allowed in all waters within Ljungdalen's FVO during time specified in the association's fishing rules.
- 2) By sport fishing is meant hook fishing with a rod brought from hand.
- 3) The fisherman is obliged to present a fishing licence and identification upon request.
- 4) The fishing license is personal and may not be transferred.
- 5) The fisherman is obliged to make sure of the rules of the fisheries conservation area.
- 6) One fishing rod per person.
- 7) Prohibition of phishing.
- 8) Prohibition of fishing with otters, with the exception that fishing right holders may fish with otters on Viksjön,
- 9) Prohibition of more than 3 hooks on the line.
- 10) Annual card with companions only applies to spouse/partner/cohabitant or a child aged 16-20 who is named on the fishing license.
- 11) Children up to the age of 15 fish for free in the company of an adult.
- 12) Prohibition to fish from floating within the entire fisheries conservation area.
- 13) Prohibition of baiting with live bait fish.
- 14) Ljungdalen's FVO applies a differentiated control fee.

SPECIAL RULES

- All fish under 35 cm must be put back
- All fish over 45 cm must be put back
- Maximum 4 fish per day and person
- Only fly fishing in Skärkån from the road bridge up to the lower skerries.

FISHING PROHIBITION

- Fishing ban 1/9-31/10 within Ljungdalen's fisheries conservation area with the exception of lower Skärvagen.
- Fishing ban in Skärkån 15/5-15/5 (grayling) between the road bridge and lower Skärvagen.
- Fishing ban in Skärvagsån 15/5-15/6 (grayling) up to Öjönån.
